WHEREAS, patients should be empowered to receive compassionate care; and

OWHEREAS, healthcare workers need to practice greater compassion towards patients, colleagues, and themselves; and

OWHEREAS, we must foster an inclusive healthcare system in which each person is treated as if the Patient is U:
